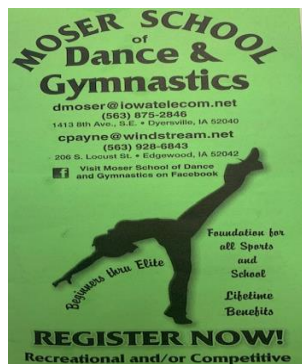
Beckman News:
