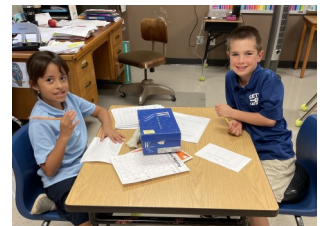
My children are not just well-educated; they are Christians with sound values and faith, greatly due to Seton Catholic's influence in their everyday lives.

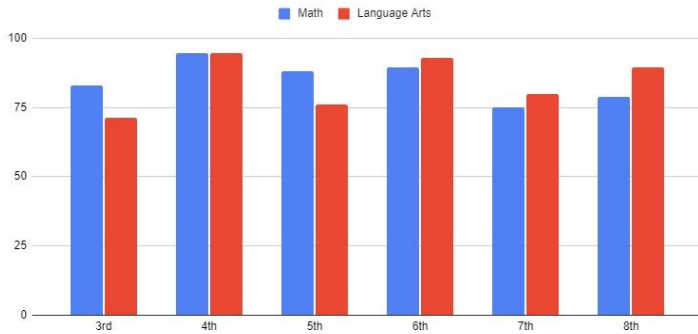

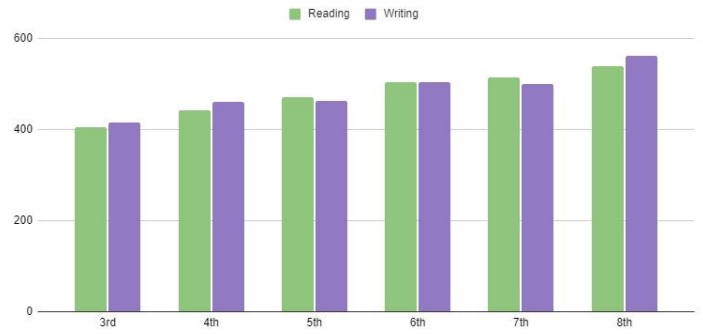

Percentage of Seton Students Proficient in Math and Language Arts

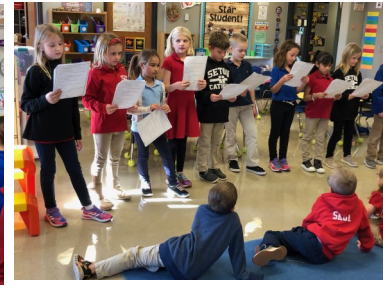
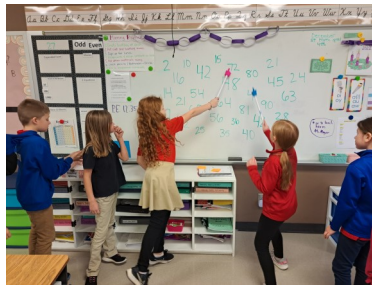


Average Language Arts Scores for Seton Students

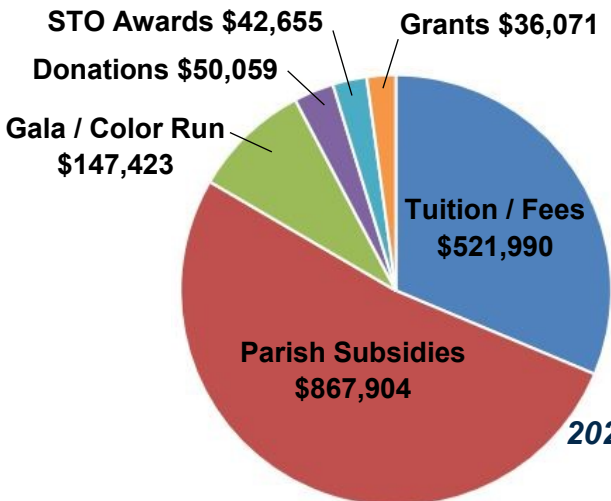

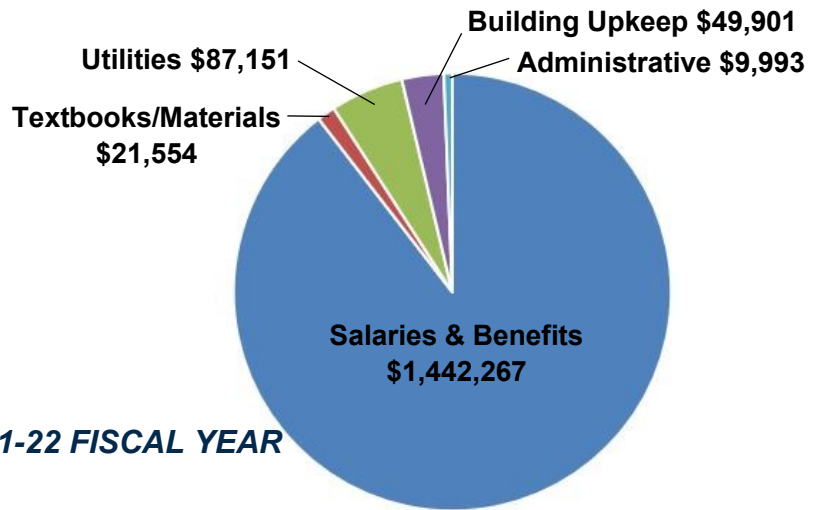
